#### **Expert advice**

Question 4.6: Are there other organisations that should be a statutory consultee on applications with Fire Statements and on what issues would they advise?

HBF are aware of the Welsh Government Joint Inspection Team that was created last year to look at providing help and advice to local authorities and high rise buildings. Given that the JIT employ building and construction experts in addition to building control bodies, it is HBF's understanding that they could operate in a similar way to the Building Safety Regulator in England. Welsh Government could consider utilising this resource to help provide advice and expedite an application for HRB building control approval in Wales.

#### **Future safeguarding arrangements**

Yes. Unless amendments in the future were able to successfully adapt and offer new fire access routes which were compliant with safety standards.

This appears to be a sensible and pragmatic offering by welsh government where each 'stage' of build can be clearly defined and controlled by building control and designers. The proposal sets out clear definitions and control mechanisms whereby proceeding on to the next stage is not permitted without full consent having been received. This staged approach potentially allows certain activities to commence such as site mobilisation, setting out, ground preparation, foundations and structure to commence whilst other critical elements of the build are able to be fully detailed and submitted to the local authority for further consideration. A staged approach could enable non fire critical works to commence as outlined above.

Contacting a sewer authority may be relevant in some instances for wider building control approval matters. It is however difficult to see the link between HRB and fire critical safety matters and a sewer authority. The two matters appear to be entirely separate to one another with sewerage connections being already covered under separate legislation in the Water Act. Any correspondence with a water company should not prohibit the issuing of a completion or occupation certificate associated with high rise building matters unless the two are explicitly linked. However connection onto an appropriate fire fighting main supply to the HRB may be considered a more applicable scenario for seeking associated approval with a water company providing the connections.

Generally HBF would wish for Welsh Government to provide and publish monthly or quarterly HRB Application & Approval reporting from LABC in order to track progress. HBF would also like to Welsh Government to consider greater LABC/RBCA involvement and engagement with HRB applications if it help provide expert opinions or help expedite complex or time consuming procedures. As registered professionals, it would be prudent to consider utilising this valuable and available resource on the occasions that it is needed. HBF wish for Welsh Government to issue strong and clear guidelines to individuals working on overseeing and approving higher risk building applications in order to avoid an inconsistent approach or contradictions in approval processes as has been experienced in England. Finally HBF would also like Welsh Government to consider allowing an opportunity for applicants of new HRB applications to engage with welsh government and the LABC for pre application stage presentation or discussion. Here there could be benefit to both parties in firstly explaining and discussing through how and where a scheme will function and operate. It would not be seen as an opportunity to form a relationship, more an opportunity to explain what the new application is, how it works and how it will comply ahead of a formal application being submitted to an approving authority.
