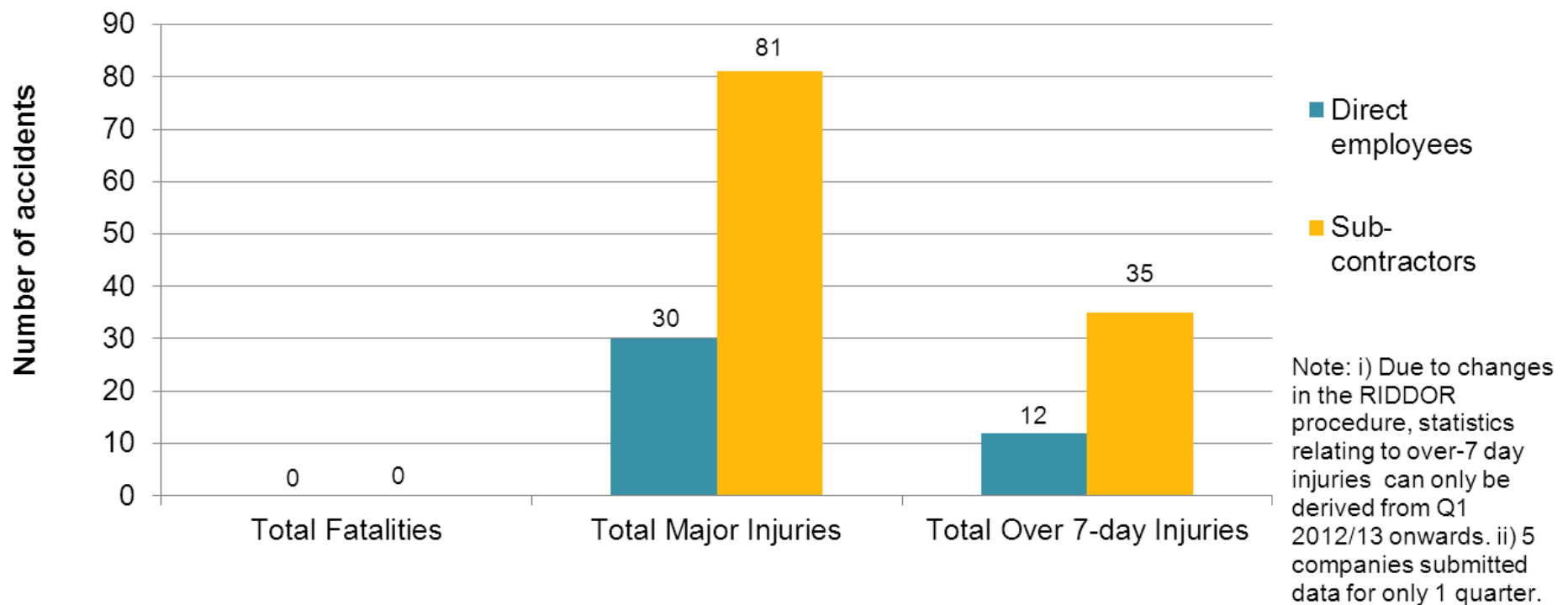

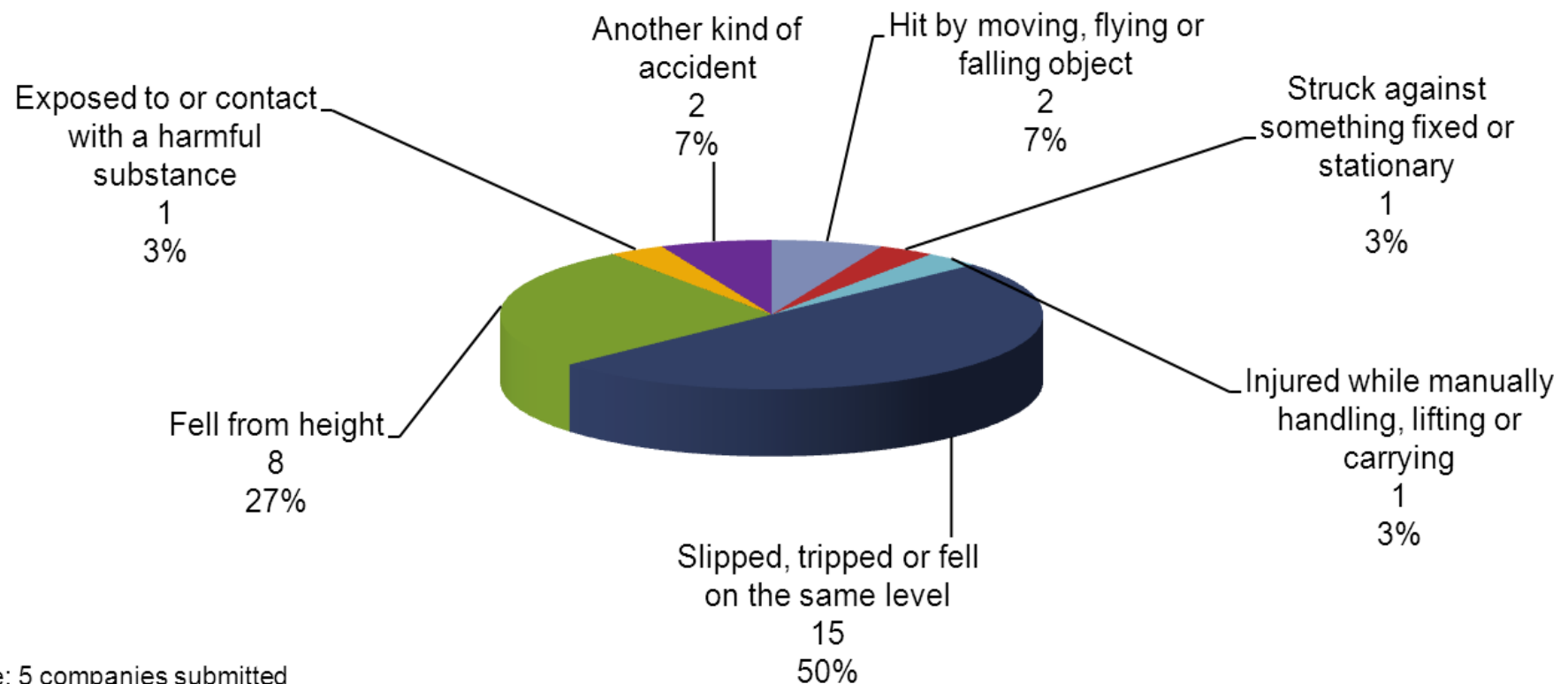

Charter Signatory Organisations - total recorded RIDDOR accidents between July 2011 - June 2012



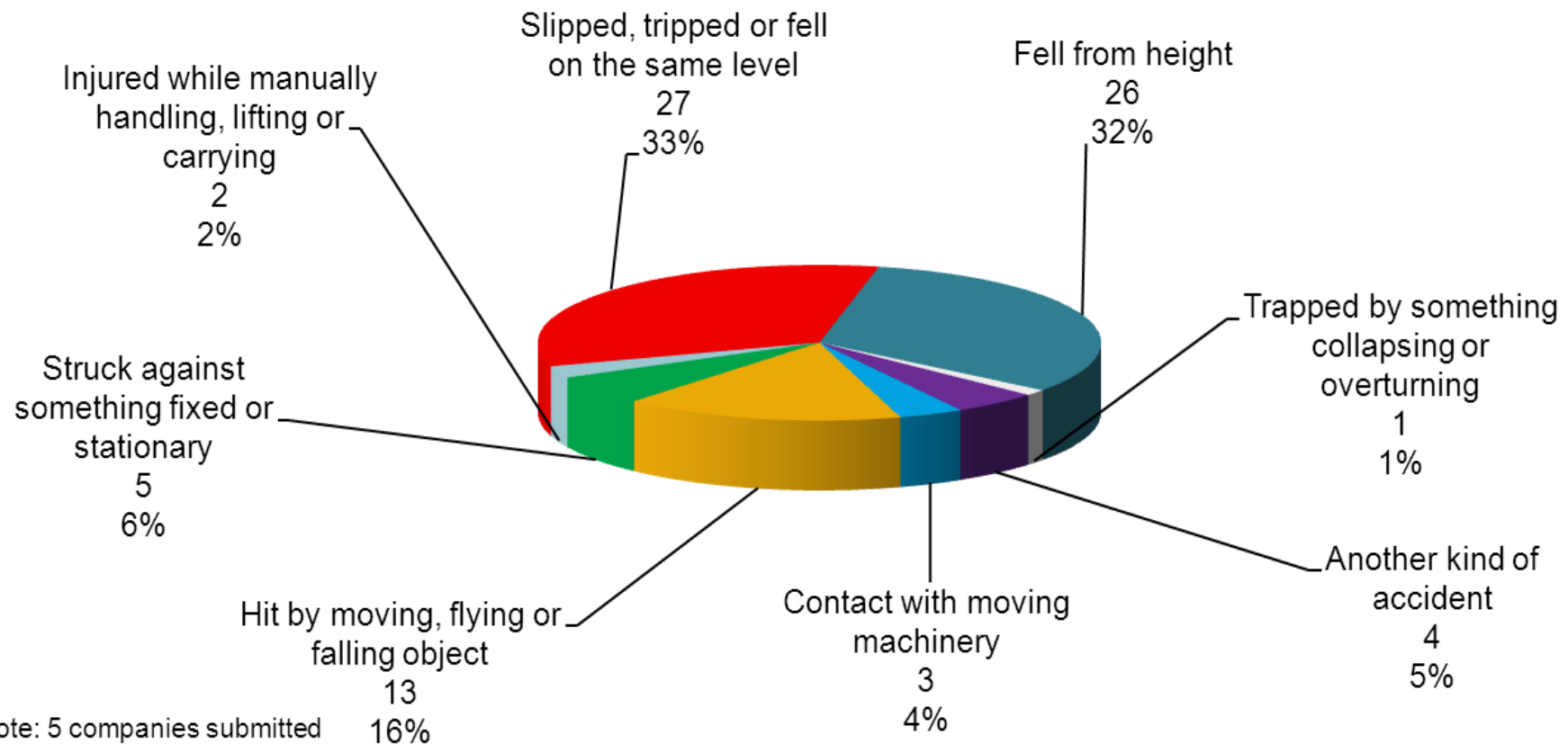
No fatalities from Charter Signatories July 2011 – June 2012

Charter Signatory Organisations - major injuries to direct employees between July 2011 - June 2012



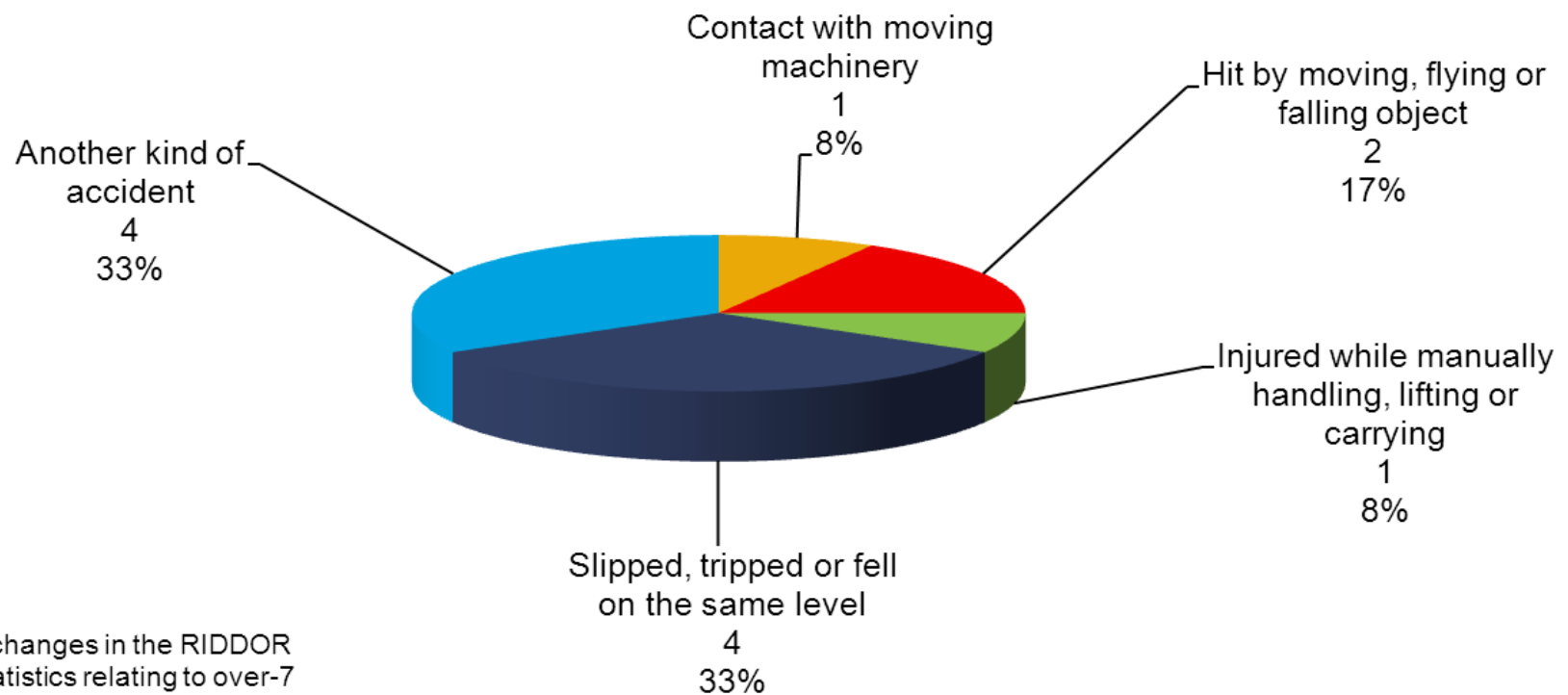

Charter Signatory Organisations - major injuries to sub-contractors between July 2011 - June 2012



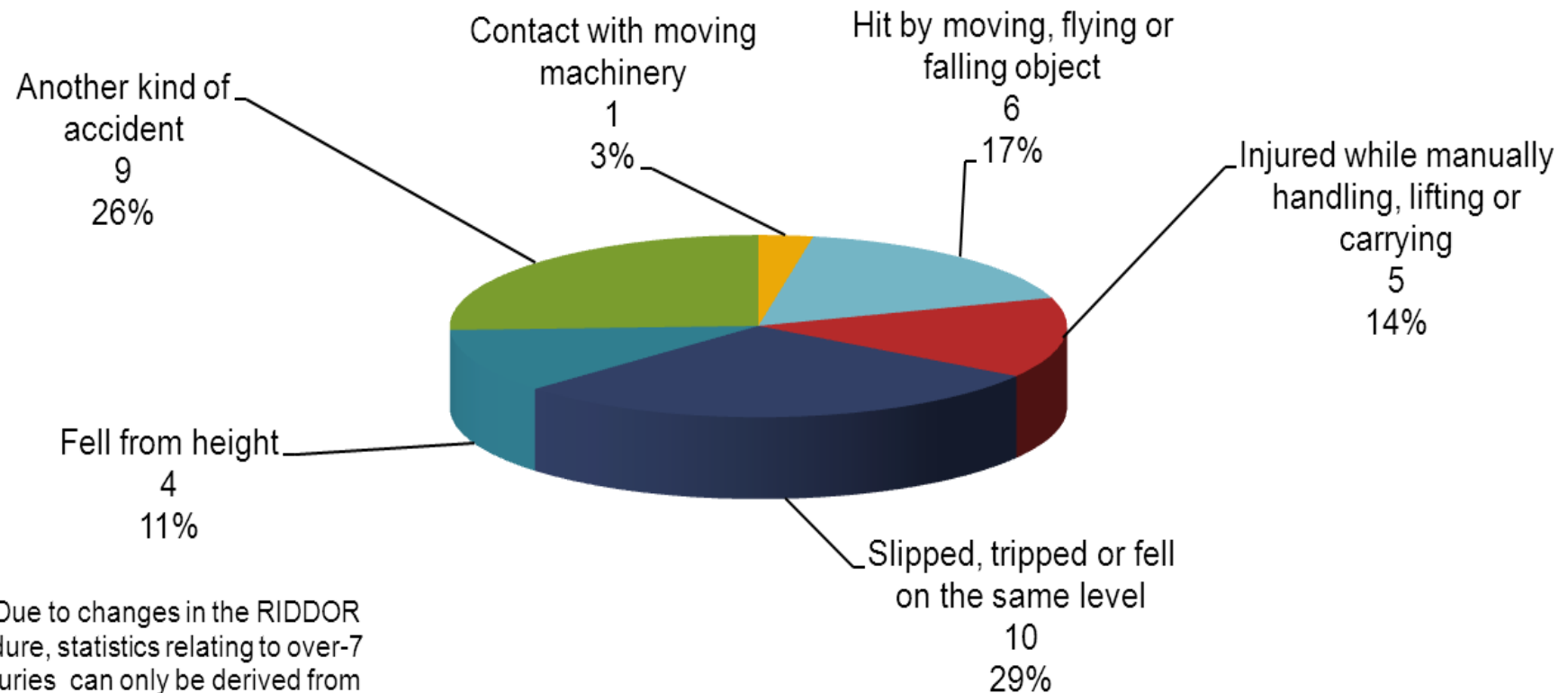

Charter Signatory Organisations - Over 7-day injuries to direct employees between April 2012 - June 2012



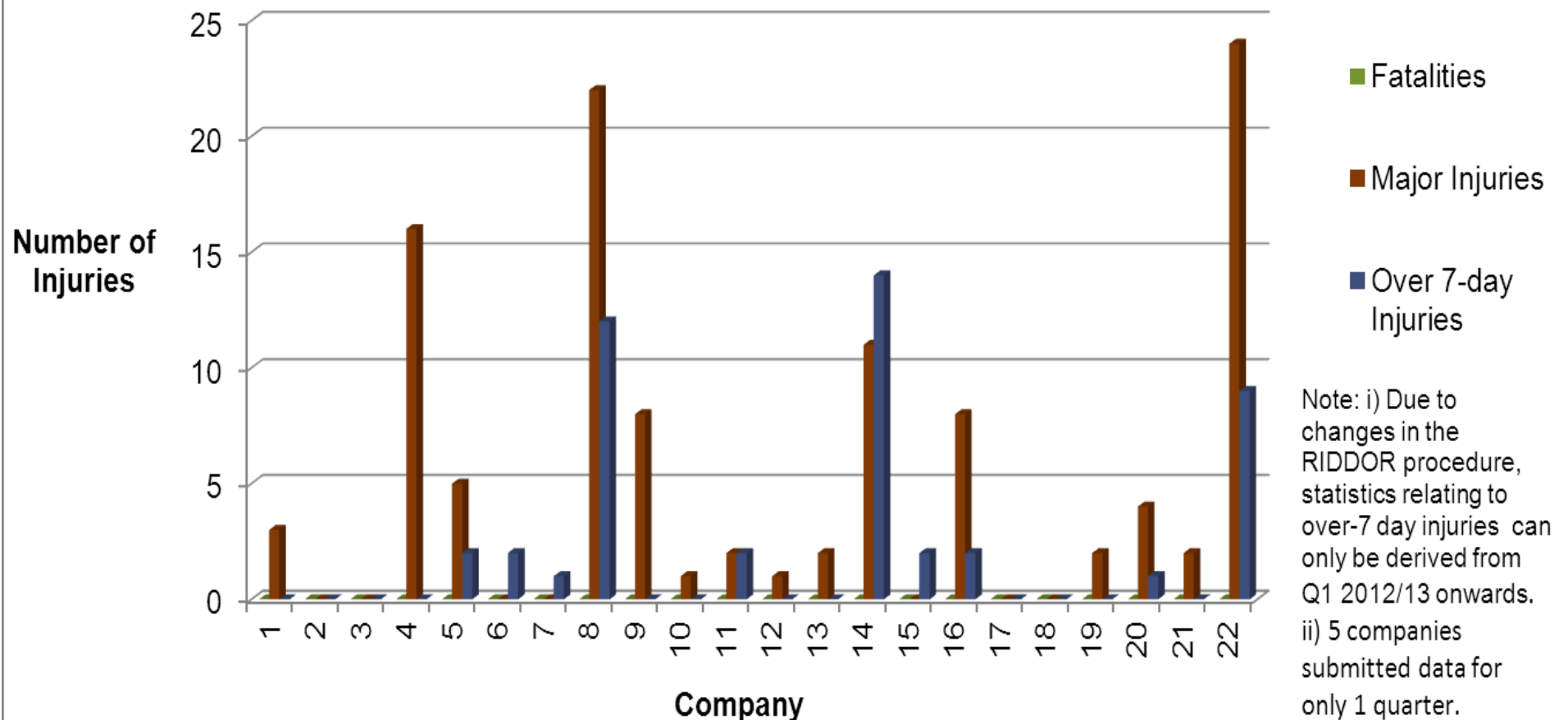

Charter Signatory Organisation - Over 7-day injuries to sub-contractors between April 2012 - June 2012

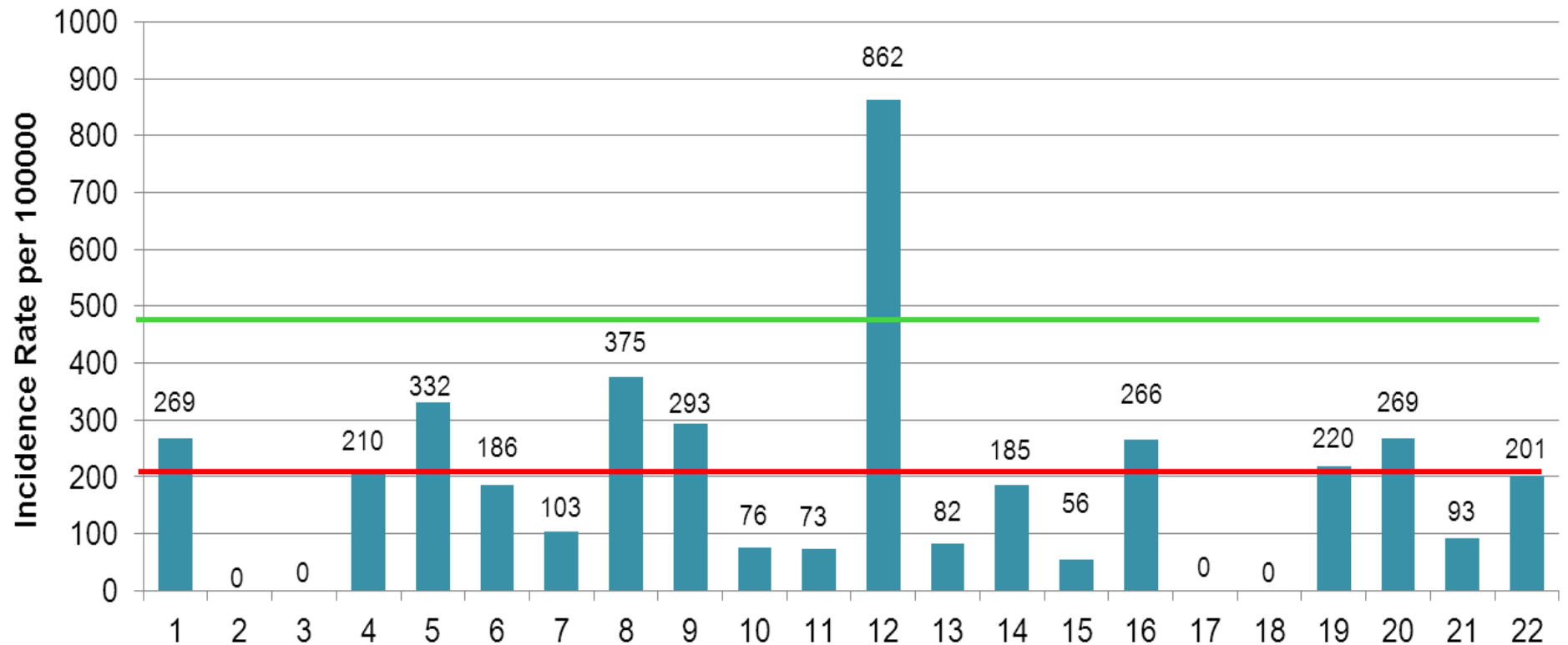

Annual Injury Incidence Rate (AIIR) Q2 2011/12 - Q1 2012/13



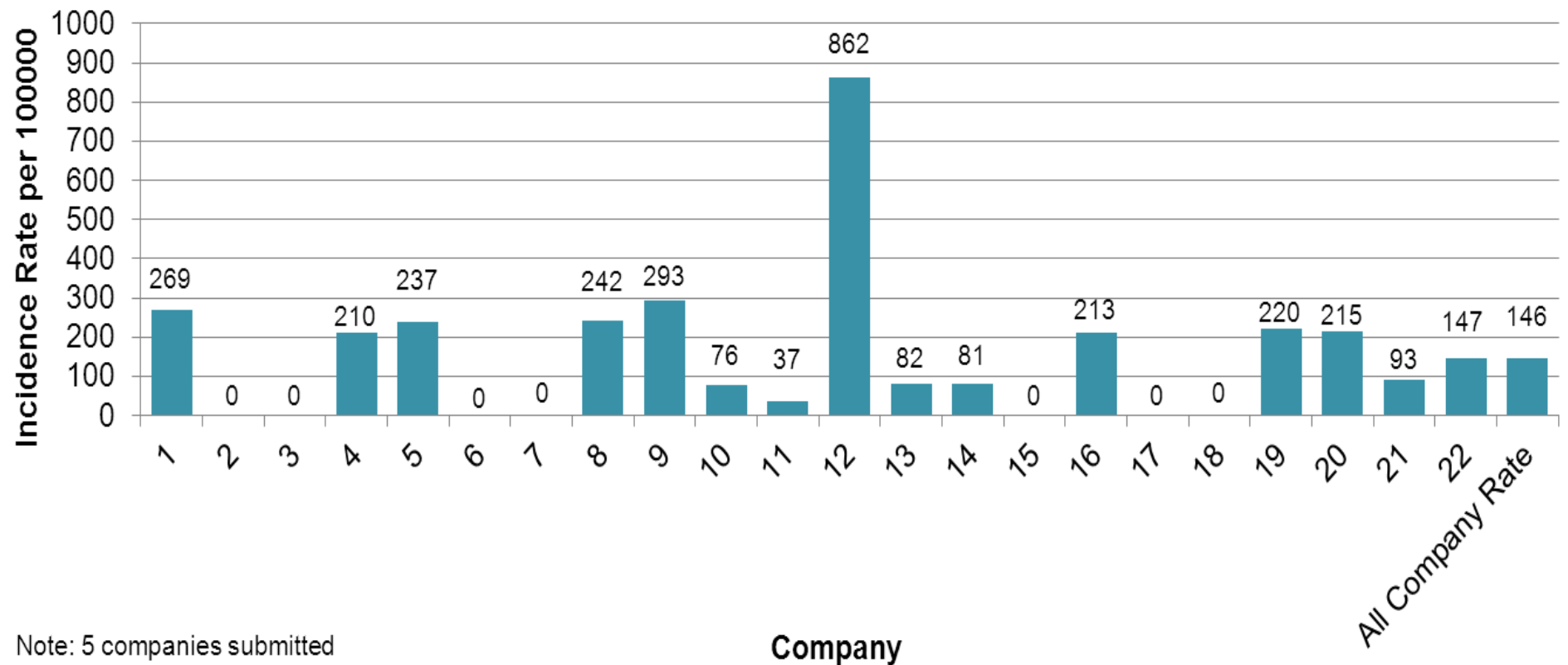

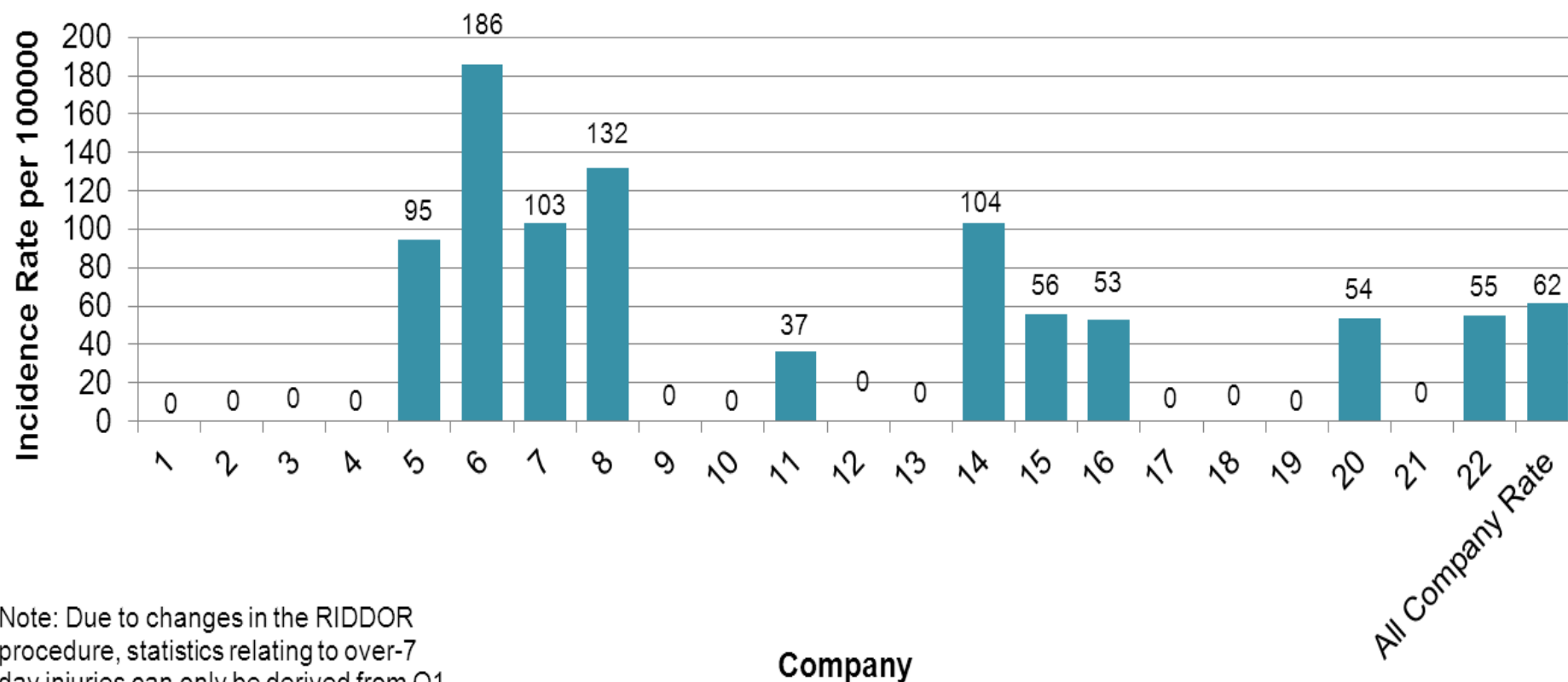
