## **Telehandler Suspended Loads**

This category has been completed and will launch in March 2015 in order to allow test centres time to update their equipment.

The category will specifically state 'non-rough terrain use' and this will be reinforced at the testing stage.

## Medical fitness to operate plant

This will be incorporated into the CPCS records but not listed on cards

## The National Plant Operators Registration Scheme (NPORS)

Following detailed discussions, the NPORS is now a UKCG 'accepted record scheme'. The move brings to an end what has effectively been a monopoly for the Construction Plant Competency Scheme (CPCS) for the most general types of construction machinery.

#### Fraud

Lots of activity against individuals and also some test centres who are not conducting tests properly. It is likely some organisations will lose their test centre licence.

## **Online Digital logbook**

This is still in development

## NVQ

Assessment criteria are being tightened and will require on site observation and a 3 month time period.

This will effectively exclude the Experienced Worker Practical Assessment (EWPA) route (which can be done at a test centre in one day) to an NVQ.

#### **Smart Cards**

There is no appetite for this.

### Testing

The maximum allowable charge for a practical test is to be reviewed.

Telehandler Renewal Test pass rate is 65% (average for all categories is 73%). Many of the failures can be attributed to lack of preparation.
